



Regional Rail LLC Acquires Conshohocken Recycling & Rail Transfer, LLC

Regional Rail, LLC announced today that it has acquired a rail served Construction and Demolition Debris (C&D) transfer station in Conshohocken, PA (formerly known as Conshohocken Rail). The new company, Conshohocken Recycling & Rail Transfer, LLC is a high throughput transfer station with dual inbound and outbound truck scales, a 25,000 sqft transfer building, and is located on a 12 acre site at 1060 Conshohocken Rd, Conshohocken, PA. The design and operation of this facility provides CCRT customers with the fastest possible turn times for trucks delivering to the facility. CRRT also owns and operates a fleet of 81 recently refurbished high capacity gondola cars for transporting the unrecyclable portion of the C&D waste stream from the greater Philadelphia area to rail served landfills, removing these large truck shipments from local roads and highways.
